Definition of Forms Associated With the Degree Application Process

<u>Letter of Intent to Graduate</u>: A form you submit to the Office of the Dean of the School of Applied Sciences that notifies your intention to graduate in an upcoming semester. After you submit that letter to our office, we update your checklist with the transcripts you provide and send you and your academic advisor a list of your remaining requirements. It is then your responsibility to work with your academic advisor to plan out your remaining semester(s) using the remaining requirement list that the dean's office sends you. You can get the form from the School of Applied Sciences Office of the Dean in the George Street House or on the school's website at http://www.olemiss.edu/depts/applied_sciences/

<u>Diploma Application</u>: An online form that you will be authorized to submit to the Office of the Registrar after your Letter of Intent to Graduate has been reviewed and completed by the Office of the Dean. The Office of the Dean does not authorize students to submit this application until the beginning of the semester in which the students intends to complete his or her degree requirements. This is an online application that must be completed in order for you to be put on the university's official list of applicants (and, therefore, be sent invitations/instructions for commencement). You cannot receive a degree from The University of Mississippi without completing the online diploma application.
