Total Enrollment: 2,759 (*up 3% since 2014-15*)

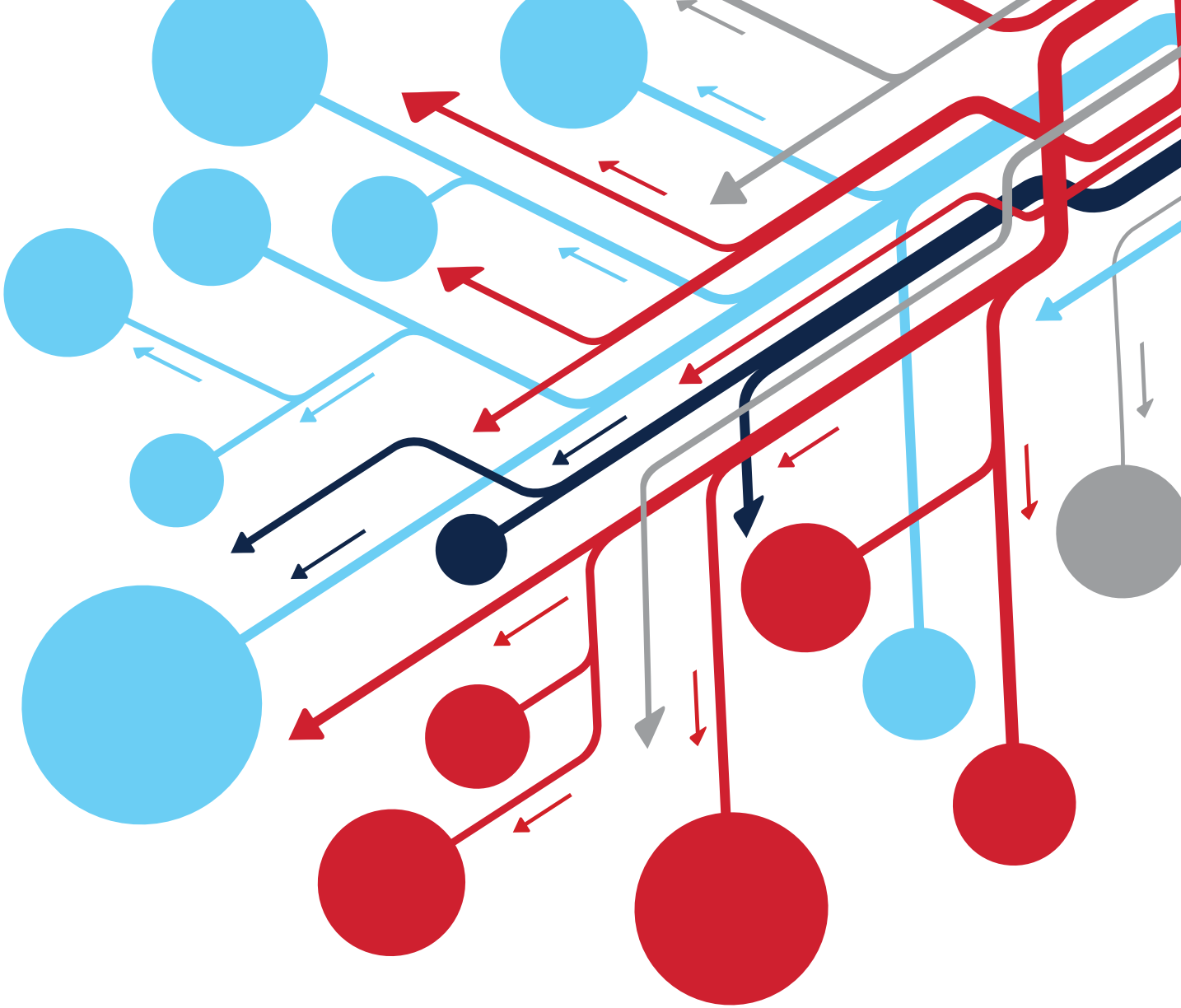

KNOW THE DEADLINES

Friday, September 9: Last day to register or add classes (Between August 28th and September 4th may only with instructor approval) Refund period ends.

Monday, October 5th: Deadline for course withdrawals. (no refund)

Before **October 5th:** Drop through MyOleMiss

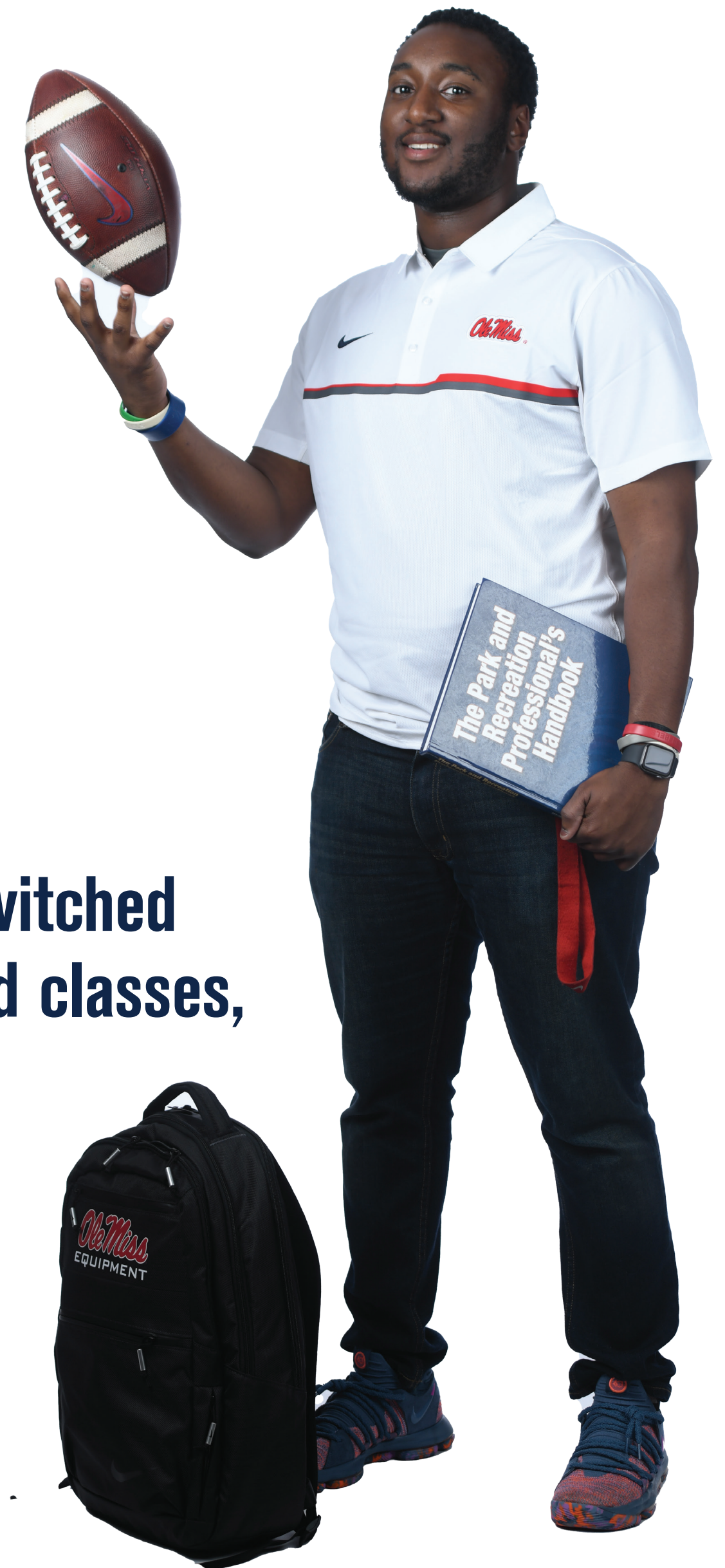
After **October 5th:** Must have Dean's Office approval

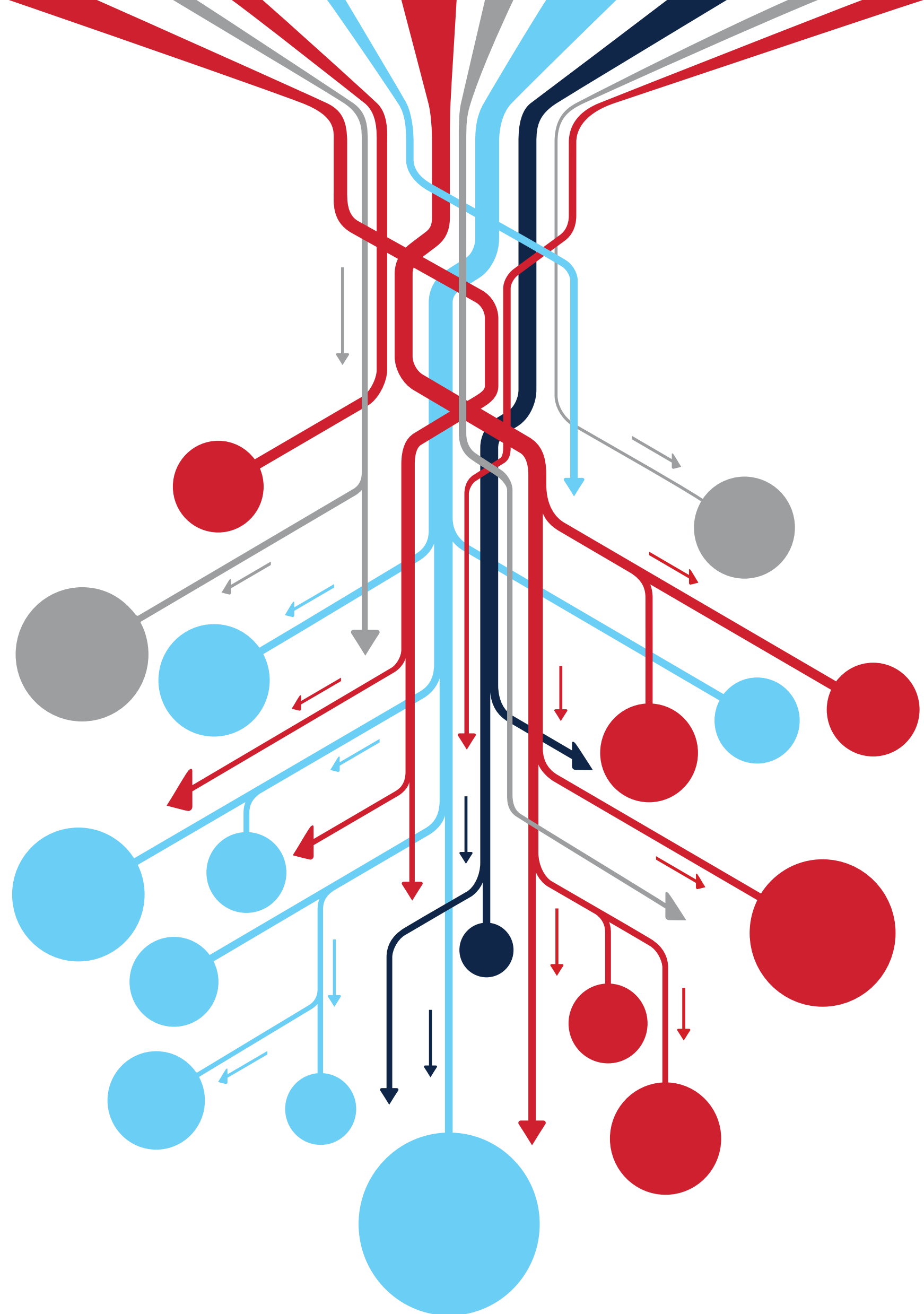
